This Declaration embodies the prescribed declaration required by Statutory Instrument SI 2007 1159 for Parish and principal Councils.

For a person elected to the Office of Chairman, the declaration must be made at the meeting at which he/she is elected. For Councillors, the declaration must be made before or at the first meeting of the Parish Council or if the Parish Council at that meeting so permit, before or at a later meeting fixed by the Council. Failure to comply with this provision will result in the Office becoming vacant.
